The Idaho State Youth Education Summit is new to Idaho this year. Often referred to as Y.E.S., it is a part of a larger national program through the NRA Foundation, a non-profit, non-political charitable affiliate of the National Rifle Association. The program is open to current sophomores or juniors in high school. The Idaho program is open to Idaho residents attending school in Idaho.

Those students selected for the Idaho Youth Education Summit will meet in Boise. There they will learn about our branches of government and visit state elected officials. They will visit the Idaho Legislature and learn about our law-making process. They will visit other governmental agencies and historical displays.

Students will have exercises in public speaking and problem-solving. The students will also be led in firearms training at a local gun range. This will be administered by certified firearms instructors.

Selection of students for the program is competitive. Students should fully complete the application with care to provide the required essay and letters of recommendation. One of the participants in the Idaho Youth Education Summit will be selected at the end of the Idaho program to go participate in the national Y.E.S. program in Washington D.C. on July 13-19, 2020. Up to \$50,000 total in scholarships will be awarded among successful participants at this national Y.E.S. program.

Successful student applicants will be required to provide their own transportation to Boise for the Y.E.S. program. They must have appropriate attire for the various programs. Once at the program, all meals, lodging, and materials are available to the students at no cost to them.

Deadline for receipt of all application materials is January 8, 2020.
